From now until March 13, 2021 homes with odd numbered addresses water on Saturday. Homes with even numbered addresses water their lawns on Sunday.

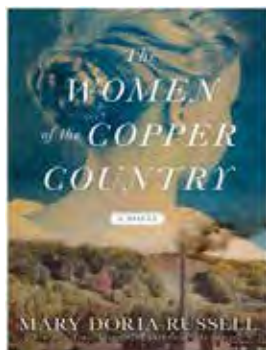

- Avoid shopping alone. Try to shop with a friend or relative.
- Park your vehicle in a well-lighted area. Put radar detectors and cellular telephones out of sight.
- Know your surroundings. Keep an eye on the people in front as well as behind you.
- Carry your purse close to your body. Don't swing it loosely. Don't flash large amounts of cash.
- Walk with confidence. Avoid talking to strangers.
- Approach your vehicle with your keys already in your hand.
- Try not to carry too many packages. Place all packages out of sight in your vehicle, preferably in the trunk.
- Keep your vehicle doors locked and your windows shut.
- If you see anything suspicious or if something just doesn't feel right, leave immediately and contact security or the police.

WHAT IS W.H.O.A.?

You have all heard the term WHOA and wondered what is WHOA? When you purchased your home in Williamsburg, every homeowner's warranty deed includes a statement that obligated you to Orange County to pay for maintaining the village's public land. In 1987, Williamsburg Homeowners Association's purpose (formed with volunteers from each village) has been to fulfill your contractual obligation to Orange County. Therefore, each month your particular village pays a small portion of your monthly dues to WHOA. As a Williamsburg homeowner, what has WHOA done for me?

- Maintained landscaping and irrigation's water and electric pumps, remove dead palm trees and shrubs on the islands.
- In addition, our retention ponds and canals are maintained.
- Coordinate with Orange County new sidewalks and safety rails and replace traffic signs.
- Worked with the Beachline Highway Authority on their obligation to maintain the islands from the overpass into Williamsburg.
- Installed new lighting for Williamsburg signs.
- Provided a voice to Orange County and Valencia Water Management leaders who listen, because we represent a major portion of their constituents and voters.

You witness each day our property values increasing. This is due in part to Williamsburg Homeowners Association. Prospective buyers drive in from the 528, Central Florida and John Young Parkway seeking a village that is well maintained and where they can see their families living.

However, since 2019 two villages no longer forward the money that you pay for this expense to WHOA.

So, we urge you to ask your village board of directors or management company if they are paying WHOA. **If Not! Why Not!**

By now, your board of directors has sent you your village's proposed 2021 budget for your approval. Please review it carefully, to ensure they have allocated the monies you have paid to them for WHOA.

Without those two villages' contributions, WHOA may be forced to eliminate landscaping, irrigation or the proposed replacing or refurbishing of the Williamsburg signs from 528.

However, that takes money that we do not have. **Why?** Because these villages have chosen NOT to send WHOA the money, you have paid to them.

- What has WHOA done for the villages in Williamsburg?
- Influenced Sea World from designing an access road to Aquatica through Win-gate and to direct loud noises to the far side of the water park away from Williamsburg.
- Encouraged Central Florida Parkway widening that would increase traffic flow to Sea World and Aquatica.
- Convinced Orange County to build a multi-purpose Shingle Creek Trail, a large dog run, bicycle path complex away from the area next to LakeRidge to Destination Parkway.
- Instrumental in persuading Orange County NOT to place toll booths at entrance on Beeline highway.

WHOA has helped to maintain our beautiful villages. Please help us continue by speaking with your village board of director or Management Company. **It is your money.**
