President's Message

In June the Board of Directors met on Zoom and we appreciate all of you that were able to join us. We will let you know if the July meeting will be on Zoom or at the clubhouse as soon as that decision is made.

At the June meeting the board voted to continue with the current restrictions regarding the use of our facilities. Everyone has done a good job of following the posted rules. Please remember how important it is that we continue to practice social distancing, frequent hand washing, use a face mask while inside the clubhouse, and most importantly, stay home if you are not feeling well. There will be a few lounge chairs out at each pool now but we still ask that you do not bring your own chairs to the pool. The bathing loads (actual number of people in the pool or spa) remains the same:

Clubhouse pool - 13

Spa - 4

North pool - 8

Terrace pool - 10

Water aerobics will begin in August after school begins.

The gym is still limited to 3 people at a time and the game room is 4 people at a time. Each user should clean the equipment before and after use. The tennis courts should be limited to 4 people playing at a time. The great room will be available Monday through Friday from 8:00am until 4:00pm. You may reserve a time slot with Nicole.

We still recommend that everyone bring their own hand sanitizer and wipes when possible.

The board also approved the amended community standards to be presented to the homeowners. This includes approved corrections to the standards pertaining to commercial vehicles and the addition of a standard that permits pavers to be used for driveways. Homeowners will receive a notice of when and where these amended standards will be available for review. At the July meeting they will be considered for official board approval.

Please complete an ARC form before you start projects to the outside of your home and property. This includes removing trees and shrubs, painting your home, new roof, etc. Always check with Nicole or our property manager before you start any project.

We continue to see trash cans, yard waste, and bulk items put out several days prior to the scheduled pickup days. Trash pickup is on Thursday and the trash cans should be placed out on Wednesday evening. Recycling, yard waste, and bulk items should be placed out on Thursday evenings for Friday pickup. All of your trash cans and other containers should be stored in your garage or behind your privacy walls. They should not be visible from the street.

Please check the information in the newsletter about the upcoming Drive-By BBQ scheduled for July 18.



RECOGNIZING HEAT-RELATED HEALTH PROBLEMS

It's important to know how to recognize the signs of heat exhaustion and heat exposure. After all, even if you're taking all necessary precautions, problems can occur. For example, if you happen to be at the park and forget the time, someone may become overheated. Heat exhaustion signs will appear first, and then heat stroke signs. Symptoms, as described by the Centers for Disease Control, are detailed below.

Heat Exhaustion

The signs of heat exhaustion may include the following:

- Breathing that is shallow and fast
- Clammy skin
- Dizziness
- Dry mouth
- Excessive sweating
- Fainting
- Headache

- Loss of color in skin
- Nausea
- Pale complexion
- Pulse that is fast and weak
- Skin that feels moist and cool (when touched)
- Sweating
- Tiredness
- Vomiting

If you see any of the above exhaustion signs, get out of the heat immediately. The person experiencing symptoms should be given plenty of cool fluids and be wiped down with cool cloths. If rapid improvement isn't seen, call 911 immediately.

Heat Stroke

The signs of major heat exposure, also known as heat stroke, include the following:

- Dizziness
- Extremely high body temperature (over 103 degrees F)
- Headache that is throbbing
- Lack of sweating
- Nausea
- Rapid pulse that is strong
- Red skin that is hot and dry (when touched)

Heat stroke always requires medical attention. If you see any of the above exposure signs, get the person out of the heat immediately and take them to the nearest hospital or call 911.
