



MOTHER'S DAY

Who Invented Mother's Day? Most of us have a treasury of nice memories of our mothers. Even those of us who do not, usually had some type mother figure in our lives who provided us with a safe haven, a comforting shoulder to cry on, and good advice when we needed to make a difficult decision. Perhaps a sister, aunt, grandmother, neighbor, or close friend.

It may surprise you to know that the woman who is responsible for Mother's Day was never a mother, herself, but she was a daughter who loved her own mother dearly. Anna M. Jarvis was a school teacher who never married; the daughter of a Methodist minister. When her mother became ill, Miss Jarvis was her devoted caretaker for 15 years, until the mother's death in 1905. After her loss, Miss Jarvis set out to find a permanent way to honor the memory of her mother, and came up with the idea of a special day to honor ALL mothers, not just her own. Unfortunately, the idea of a national day to honor mothers did not catch on easily. For several years, Miss Jarvis waged a letter-writing campaign. A barrage of letters from Miss Jarvis and her friends began to arrive at the homes of influential people, all the way up to the president, himself.

Miss Jarvis coined the name, "Mother's Day," and obtained a copyright for the name from the U.S. Patent Office. Finally, after years of speeches and letter writing, her efforts paid off and Mother's Day became a national observance when President

WILLIAMSBURG TOWN HALL MEETING MARCH 12, 2020

The Town Hall meeting at Greenbrier Clubhouse was well attended and purposeful. One hundred twenty residents and speakers attended, mostly seated apart for health reasons. Commissioner VanderLey thanked the WHOA liaison, Donna Finklestein, for her dedication and fine work setting up the meeting. Then she gave an overview of the evening, referred to our previous letter and introduced the following:

Eric Rasch of the Orange County Planning Department, spoke of the growth and development of the area. Fifteen hundred speakers move here weekly! Williamsburg was the first development in Orange County. "Our" MacDonalds is being enlarged again by about 90 square feet!

Brian Sanders of the Orange County Transportation Department, described numerous roadway projects including the completed Destination Parkway as well as current projects under construction including the John Young Parkway flyover Sand Lake Road and the associated Sand Lake Road widening to I-4, the Darryl Carter Parkway extension, and the Kirkman Road extension from Universal Blvd to Sand Lake Road as part of the Epic Universal development. Future roadway projects include the revised Sand Lake Road/I-4 interchange including a dedicated ramp to replace the left turn lane from Sand Lake Road westbound to Turkey Lake Road southbound, the addition of transit lanes to International and Universal Drives, the widening of Sand Lake Road from I-4 to Apopka-Vineland Road, the completion of the Shingle Creek bicycle and pedestrian trail from Destination Parkway to the Orange/Osceola County line to meet an existing trail, and the proposed Westwood Blvd extension. Longer term projects include future widening of I-4 south from Kirkman Road as well as a potential new interchange to the Florida Turnpike at John Young Parkway.

Humberto Castillero, the Orange County traffic engineer, referred to the specifications for a traffic light at the corner of Gateway Ave. and Orangewood Blvd. There will be two lanes and a left turn lane on Orangewood, and one lane with both right and left turn lanes on Gateway. They are now considering an eight hour or four hour vehicle volume times, as well as, peak vehicle volume studies.

Crash data revealed a total of 38 crashes in five years. Bidding will go out from January to May of 2021, with a construction completion date for the light in December of 2021. Cost: \$750,000.00

Orange County Fire Rescue Chief Wajda spoke of Fire Stations #54, #56 and #57. They receive over 130,000 calls from our area. A total of 162 patients were transported to hospitals; there were 7 drowning calls. They also deliver free smoke detectors!

Orange County Sheriff John Mina is prepared for the fifteen hundred people who move into Orange County each week. He trained and hired 150 deputies in 2019 and plans to train/hire 200 more in 2020, of which 40% will again be veterans.

\$200,000.00 was spent on 128 gun safes for 121 schools after the Parkland tragedy. In 2019 alone there were 187 opioid deaths to our population. Currently, the life-saving spray NARCON is given to all deputies to potentially save lives.

Of the 25,000 arrests last year, 13,000 were felonies and 12,000 were misdemeanors. Overall, crime is down in the County. Burglaries in Williamsburg are down 90%; auto theft down 28% and 56,000 traffic tickets were given.

Advice if you see low flying helicopters, call the FAA. For traffic problems, call Captain Ken Parker at 407-354-0889, located at 6817 Westward Blvd.

During the ensuing question/answer period, Commissioner VanderLey noted that she is requesting that the federal government include tourists in our Census! She feels that our needs are increased with the millions of tourists cared for annually.

She has loosened the regulations of "granny" apartments due to the shortage of affordable apartments. In response to our concerns re: short term rentals, Commissioner VanderLey recommends that each village of WHOA change its Bi-Laws to prohibit short-term rentals NOW - prior to Tallahassee possibly changing the law.

The Commissioner is pleased to know that WHOA is viable and strong; she will continue to work with us to solve our present and future needs.





Woodrow Wilson signed it into effect in 1914.

Anna Jarvis lived another 34 years and was able to see her idea grow, not only across the United States, but also to spread to many other countries. She spent much of her time promoting the new holiday. Unfortunately, however, the day, like many other holidays, became so commercialized that Miss Jarvis had deep regrets that she had been instrumental in bringing the day about. Much of Miss Jarvis' remaining money was spent in a fight to keep Mother's Day from being promoted as nothing more than another occasion for people to buy expensive gifts, but she did not succeed.

When Anna Jarvis passed away in 1948, a wreath of 43 carnations, her mother's favorite flower, adorned her grave, depicting the 43 countries that now celebrated Mother's Day.

With Mother's Day, 2008, almost upon us, why not remember the true meaning of the day and present your Mother a gift of lasting value? (Not that mothers don't appreciate flowers, perfume, and candy—I know—I'm a mother.) But how much more would a plant or tree, a special book donated to the local library in your mother's name, a monetary gift to a struggling college student, or a food basket dropped off at her church mean? And how much more it would have meant to Anna Jarvis, who envisioned a day to honor all Mothers, not just another day to benefit shopkeepers.
