Due to COVID restrictions this meeting was for a limited number of Board members only from each of the Williamsburg communities. Some of the items discussed were speeding, the traffic light that's been scheduled for the 4-

way intersection on Orangewood Boulevard, crime in our area, and when will Central Florida Parkway be widened. Since the meeting occurred after this article was submitted there will be a full report on the meeting in the April newsletter.

I would like to thank everyone for continuing to follow the clubhouse and pool rules. It's important that we all continue to practice social distancing and wear face coverings when inside the clubhouse. Adapting to the "new normal" has been difficult but necessary in helping us to stop the spread.

As always, we at Weber Environmental Services, Inc. (W.E.S.) Thank You for your continued business. We are honored to provide our landscape maintenance services for your community.

Beginning in April, our weekly maintenance services begin and will go through the end of October. Also, W.E.S. will be installing fresh mulch throughout the common area landscape beds, trimming the palm trees, installing fresh annuals in the flower beds, and installing granular fertilizer on the turf. Those residents who have private horticulture services or wish to be added to the horticulture skip list, please contact Nicole at the clubhouse office if you are not already on it.

Irrigation systems in Orange County may increase irrigation watering days to twice per week from the second Sunday of March until the first Sunday in November. Houses with odd numbered addresses may irrigate on Wednesday and Saturday and even numbered addresses may irrigate on Thursday and Sunday. W.E.S. recommends zone run times of 15-20 min. for spray head zones, and 30-45 min. for rotor zones. Now is the time of year to check that rain sensors and pop-up spray heads are working properly. Worn out springs and gears in pop-ups cause heads to not retract properly and can be easily broken off when mowing the turf. It is important to frequently inspect that your systems are working properly. W.E.S. recommends irrigation inspections once per month.

Again, we Thank You and look forward to servicing your properties weekly in April. Please contact us for all of your arbor care, landscape renovations, water drainage systems, and irrigation needs.
