## President's Message

During the May meeting the Board voted on the following business items:

1. The Board voted to assist the other villages with the cost of mowing the entrance to Williamsburg. This includes the area from the Williamsburg signs to the first traffic light at the start of Universal Boulevard.
2. We have been having trouble with the security cameras at the clubhouse and both satellite pools. The system is old, outdated, and it has been recommended that the best solution is to install a new system. The Board voted to install a new system. These new cameras will be digital and they will be maintained and serviced by Meridian Computer Corporation.
3. There have been several complaints about the landscaping at the second entrance to Parkview blocking the view onto Orangewood Boulevard. The Board approved a proposal from Weber to correct that problem.
4. The Board approved a proposal from the Construction Committee to replace the existing floor in the great room with tile.

In accordance with CDC guidelines face coverings are now optional in the clubhouse for those individuals that are fully vaccinated. **If you are not fully vaccinated, face coverings are still required.** The rules limiting the

number of people in the pool, recreation room, and game room have been lifted as well. The rules pertaining to the great room are still in place until all renovation is completed and it is safe for us to host large gatherings. The great room will be open during weekdays from 8:00am until 4:00pm. On behalf of the Board I want to thank all of our homeowners and residents for their cooperation with the rules that have been in place during this pandemic.

Remember that hurricane season starts June 1st! There is an excellent article in the newsletter on hurricane preparedness by Joe Grelish. I hope you will take a few minutes to check it out.

Please make sure that you complete an ARC form before you start any projects on the exterior of your home, driveway, including the planting or removal of trees and shrubs. If you have any questions concerning your project please call Nicole at the clubhouse. The ARC forms are available at the clubhouse, on our website, and on the back of this newsletter. In the last few weeks, we have observed several cars parking in unauthorized parking spaces such as the Terrace and North Pool parking lots overnight as well as the clubhouse parking. If you have a visitor for a couple of days and need an additional parking spot, please call or come to the clubhouse HOA office to notify the property manager. Please keep in mind when parking on the street; it is against the law to park your vehicle in the opposite direction of traffic and park too close to county street signs. Also, it is a violation of the association's covenants and Orange County ordinances to park an inoperable or unlicensed vehicle within the community unless in an enclosed garage. The Orange County Sheriff Department employs a specific patrol that frequents the neighborhoods to cite violations such as these. Please remember if you see something say something, please contact the police 911 or the non-emergency sheriff number ant 407-836-HELP.

It has also been observed that many recycle/trash containers are being left out in front view on the day after pick up. Please be aware that all trash/recycle containers must be stored out of sight by the end of the pick-up day.

We would like to remind homeowners that Weber Environmental is responsible for mowing, concrete edging and fertilizing each individual lot and

common areas only. We are starting to see some green coming back into our landscaping and lawns. Residents please remember to make sure that your irrigation is working properly so that the lawns remain green and healthy throughout the year.

Friends and Neighbors,  
The 2021 - 2022 Hurricane Season is upon us as of June 1st. Now is the time to prepare! Although many of us are veterans of these storms, we must not be complacent.

The following are some suggestions and recommendations you heard before, however, going back to basics is always best.

Schedule these activities and put them on your calendar, or they won't get done! We all belong to the procrastinators club. It just depends where you are on the linear scale.

Get your calendar, pens and/or pencils. Check your homeowners insurance. It may need an adjustment because building materials are up 200 - 400 percent and rising.

Prepare your home's exterior.

Thin your trees so the wind may pass through easier, or cut them down with your HOA approval. Also have your roof inspected.

Ensure your gutters, downspouts and drains are totally clear.

Remove and properly stow anything, and everything, that may become a missile. Have your neighbors do the same. Place all your important paperwork, medical information, medicine, names and phone numbers of relatives in a waterproof bag, box or container for you to take if necessary.

Have 3 - 4 days of drinking water per person, non perishable food supply.

Propane and/or charcoal, flashlights, candles, weather radio, proper clothing, etc.

Please make all the necessary arrangements for your pets.

Freeze blocks of ice in half gallon milk jugs. They last much longer than ice cubes.

Hurricane Charley 15+ years ago taught us to run down the perishable items in your freezer. If power is lost for several days, all your perishables will

spoil unless you have a generator and proper extension cords.

Ensure your generator is serviced, tested and placed outside with proper ventilation.

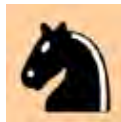

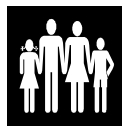

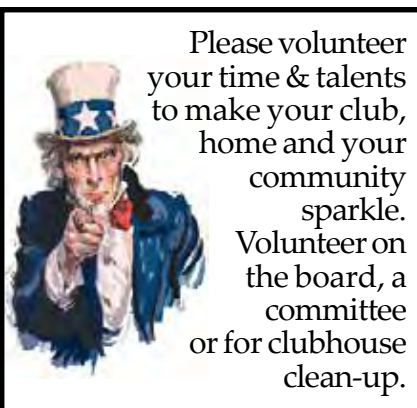

## FLAG DAY IN THE UNITED STATES

On June 14, 1777, the Continental Congress replaced the British symbols of the Grand Union flag with a new design featuring 13 white stars in a circle on a field of blue and 13 red and white stripes – one for each state. Although it is not certain, this flag may have been made by the Philadelphia seamstress Betsy Ross, who was an official flag maker for the Pennsylvania Navy. The number of stars increased as the new states entered the Union, but the number of stripes stopped at 15 and was later returned to 13.

In June 1886 Bernard Cigrand made his first public proposal for the annual observance of the birth

of the flag when he wrote an article titled "The Fourteenth of June" in the old Chicago Argus newspaper. Cigrand's effort to ensure national observance of Flag Day finally came when President Woodrow Wilson issued a proclamation calling for a nationwide observance of the event on June 14, 1916. However, Flag Day did not become official until August 1949, when President Harry Truman signed the legislation and proclaimed June 14 as Flag Day. In 1966, Congress also requested that the President issue annually a proclamation designating the week in which June 14 occurs as National Flag Week.

The President is requested to issue each year a proclamation to: call on government officials in the USA to display the flag of the United States on all government buildings on Flag Day; and to urge US residents to observe Flag Day as the anniversary of the adoption on June 14, 1777, by the Continental Congress of the Stars and Stripes as the official flag of the United States.

### Symbols

The American flag, also nicknamed as "Old Glory" or "star-spangled banner", has changed designs over the centuries. It consists of 13 equal horizontal stripes of red (top and bottom) alternating with white, with a blue rectangle in the canton bearing 50 small, white, five-pointed stars. Each of the 50 stars represents one of the 50 states in the United States and the 13 stripes represent the original 13 colonies that became the first states in the Union.
