Emergency Preparedness Items

- Prepare a car kit to include a flash light, jumper cables, tool kit, etc.
- Make sure to have NOAA Weather Radio.
- Make sure to have an extra fire extinguisher.
- Make sure to have an inventory of all personal and household items.
- Cell Phone Emergency Contact: Save ICE on your cell phone under contacts with your emergency contact information just in case.
- Make sure to have enough bottled water and canned goods stored away in your pantry.

Home Landscaping

It has recently been observed that some residents have removed substantial portions of the original landscape design without approval from the Association's Architectural Review Committee. Please know that this landscaping must be replaced under the original design or an ARC application submitted to the committee. The Board has recently directed that a review of the community be conducted to identify specific addresses with notices sent. Below are sections from the ARC Guidelines that speak to this issue. 
-All ARC applications for changes to lawn and landscaping areas must include a plot plan showing the proposed and existing location(s) and mature sizes of the plant, tree or other landscaping material. The plot plan must show accurate spacing between all new or moved items in relation to all other objects to show a 6 ft. clear path for lawn service equipment.

Neighbors and Friends,
This month we are explaining the classic definition of a "Civic Organization". WHOA is a Civic Organization, and NOT an HOA.

Question: What powers do civic associations have...?

Answer: A civic association is a group of citizens who have voluntarily joined together for collective action on community affairs. For WHOA this includes the villages of Lime Tree, Montpelier, Lake Ridge, Green Briar, Parkview Pointe and Somerset.

Question: How can they affect county or city governments...?

Answer: The objectives of a Civic Organization is to preserve, enhance, protect and plan for community improvements with the county, state and adjacent entities to ensure the welfare and safety of all.

The power of a civic association is organized public opinion. A single voice is often unheeded by businessmen and officials, but a spokesman for a civic association is recognized because he or she represents the plurality of their organization.

When the villages act together through their civic organization, they become a strong voice that does have a powerful affect with the county, state and adjacent entities.

WHOA addresses schools, bussing, assessments, roads, recreation, traffic congestion, zoning, county services and life – safety issues.

WHOA may present before the OPCS school board, county commissioners, planning commissions, or any other local entities.

WHOA is pursuing resolutions for repairing, or replacing, the Williamsburg signs just south of Highway 528. Raising the funds to complete these signs is a top priority. We are also pursuing statute updates when the new traffic light will be installed, and the legality of he-

licopter flight paths, and times. Commissioner Wilson and Senior Aid, Lee Perry are extremely dedicated to the Williamsburg community. Senior Aid, Lee Perry spearheaded a safety issue working with the FDOT to eliminate a dangerous short cut made by motorists. Bollards and landscaping were installed to hopefully eliminate the danger. WHOA will meet with Commissioner Wilson and Lee Perry again this month, continuing to pursue viable solutions to all known issues.

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



CANINE OBESITY - FUN FACTS

Did you know Approximately 50% of U.S. dogs are overweight or obese.

Do you have a pudgy pooch? If you break a sweat when picking your dog up or you notice he cleans the floors with his stomach – there is a problem! All joking aside, health risks of obesity are real. It contributes to many medical conditions such as diabetes, arthritis, heart and lung disease, high blood pressure, compromised immune function and

can even predispose to certain types of cancer. It has been well documented that dogs maintaining an ideal body weight live 10% longer, and with less disease, than overweight dogs. It is a fact that dogs will live shorter lives if obesity is not addressed.

While most dog owners realize their dog may be a “little heavy” they often don’t recognize when their dog is truly obese. When a vet says “Fido” should lose 5 pounds, it often goes in one ear and right out the other. Really who doesn’t have 5 pounds to lose. But this is us thinking in human weight terms.. Did you know: 5 extra pounds on a (should-be) 12 pound Shih Tzu is like 58 extra pounds on a 140-pound woman. 5 extra pounds on a (should-be) 25 pound Beagle is like 28 extra pounds on a 140-pound woman. 5 extra pounds on a (should-be) 70 pound Lab Retriever is like 10 extra pounds on a 140-pound woman.

The first dog in this example is morbidly obese at 42% over ideal body weight. The second dog is also obese at 20% over ideal body weight. The third dog is overweight at 7% over ideal body weight.
